## Police Report

This report was presented by the chairman.

The report recorded 2 vehicle collisions and 3 incidents of anti-social behavior.

Two incidents on Loch Lomond had occurred—no serious injuries.

The Chairman/Secretary annual report was presented.

The following points of discussion followed

The C6 overhanging branches had been cleared except for a section near Cashel (To be dealt with)

The cycle access at the Whinny D, as explained by AP, was necessary because the cycle pavement was too narrow at that point—also the landowner keeps any rights associated.

Yellow lines for parking restriction were discussed as there was concern that no cones for safety had been used.

JT explained that a meeting to try to find solutions to the chaotic parking in Balmaha had been held and another more focused meeting was planned for early June.

AP&LB were unhappy not to have been included and JT apologised for not inviting them. He had thought that the problem was only of special interest to those living in Balmaha.
